

VA REPORT TO COUNCIL

Spires Paving has completed the OPWC paving project. The Village was able to pave Basil Western and have the pavement striped, Water Street was paved and striped with the R/R crossing painted, North Street was paved, Railroad Street was paved and the intersection of Oak and Railroad was paved with an ADA sidewalk ramp installed.

The Village has surveyed the drainage ditch on Basil Western Rd. and Village crew will excavate the east side of the road and install a new catch basin. This will prevent water from collecting along the road and help preserve the pavement.

I scheduled a two hour educational seminar for planning and zoning on October 10, 2013 at 7pm. All members of council are invited to attend.

The Village dedicated Bope Warehouse Park last Wednesday. There were about twenty five people who attended the ceremony.

Saturday August 17, 2013 is the last day the pool will be open for the 2013 season.

The Village intends to paint the Basil Park Shelter house and install the new playground equipment before the end of August.

The Village installed all the One-Way signs on Brown and Kumler. The Village also overlaid Yencer Ave. with the durapatcher in anticipation of increased traffic as a result of the newly enacted One-Way on Brown and Kumler.

I am working on this year's OPWC application. The engineer, street supervisor and I have identified potential streets for repair and will present these to the service committee.
