AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO PAY BRICKER & ECKLER, LLP FOR PROFESSIONAL LEGAL SERVICES AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY


WHEREAS, the services of Bricker & Eckler, LLP, were solicited to represent the Village in the matter of the preparation of bidding and contract documents for the Water Treatment Plant Improvements Project (hereinafter "the Project"); and,

WHEREAS, in order for bidding and contract documents and related matters to be prepared and issued in a timely fashion, this ordinance needs to be approved on an emergency basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to pay to Bricker & Eckler, LLP, for professional services rendered for the above Water Treatment Plant Improvements Project, in an amount not exceeding \$10,000.00. A copy of the contract shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
