**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD A CONTRACT
TO THE OHIO PLAN RISK MANAGEMENT, INC.,
TO SUPPLY GENERAL LIABILITY AND PROPERTY
INSURANCE COVERAGE TO THE VILLAGE
AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Baltimore requires insurance coverage for its real property, equipment, vehicle coverage, and general liability (including, but not being limited to: public officials, law enforcement officers and Village Solicitor); and,

WHEREAS, informal bids have been received and it has been determined to purchase insurance from The Ohio Plan Risk Management, Inc. (Ohio Plan, Inc.); and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the informal bids and recommends the adoption of this ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, since the contract with Wichert will lapse on June 1, 2014, and in order to ensure liability insurance coverage for the Village's properties, this ordinance will need to be passed as an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Ohio Plan, Inc., to provide the general liability and property insurance needs of the Village of Baltimore in an amount not to exceed \$31,189.00 for the period from June 1, 2014 to May 31, 2015, per the terms and conditions contained in the proposal attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the community. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
