

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 2014-42

Passed JANUARY 12 2015

## AN ORDINANCE TO INITIATE A SIDEWALK RESTORATION GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Village desires to initiate a "Sidewalk Restoration Grant Program;" and,

WHEREAS, property owners have the opportunity to apply for said grant money for sidewalk restoration for sidewalks located on their properties; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has recommended the initiation of said program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village initiate the "Sidewalk Restoration Grant Program" for properties in the Village. The grant shall be funded with a maximum amount of \$5,000.00 for 2015, and shall be available to property owners on a first come, first served basis. There shall be one award per property per year, for reimbursement up to the sum of thirty percent (30%) of the project cost but in no fashion to exceed the sum of \$500.00. Applicants may apply for said grant money by March 31<sup>st</sup> for the second quarter; June 30<sup>th</sup> for the third quarter; September 30<sup>th</sup> for the fourth quarter, and December 20<sup>th</sup>, for the first quarter of the following year. Reimbursement shall be awarded after the work has been fully completed and inspected by the Village Administrator, and verification of project costs submitted to and confirmed by the Village.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest period authorized by law.
