**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP
TO MAKE BROWN STREET A TWO-WAY STREET
RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH FROM
WASHINGTON STREET TO KUMLER STREET,
AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:**

SECTION 1: The Village's Traffic Control Map is hereby amended to provide for the following:

Brown Street is hereby designated on the Traffic Control Map as a "two-way street," running north and south from Washington Street to Kumler Street.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Accordingly, this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council and after the erection of the necessary signage and the appropriate designations on the traffic control map.




