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**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS FOR THE CDBG NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION, FOR VARIOUS PROJECTS, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to participate in the grant application process for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Neighborhood Revitalization Program administered by the Fairfield County's Regional Planning Commission, for the following projects: Market Street Sidewalk Project; Johnson Street Storm Drain Improvement Project; Mill Street Paving Project; and Sanitary Sewer Improvement North of West Maple Street and West of North Basil Street Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Village agrees to provide engineering services and pay the costs of the engineering services for the above projects, in the amount of \$43,780.00; and,

WHEREAS, since this resolution must be approved and effective before the application deadline, this resolution shall be passed on an emergency basis;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village is hereby authorized to participate in and cooperate with the Fairfield County Regional Planning Commission in the grant application process for the projects set forth above.

SECTION 2: That the Village shall provide engineering services and pay the costs of the engineering services for the projects set forth above, in the amount of \$43,780.00.

SECTION 3: That the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining the grant assistance set forth herein.

SECTION 4: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
