**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND
AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH ELAVON/U.S. BANK FOR THE PROVISION OF
A SERVICE FEE PROGRAM FOR CREDIT CARD USERS**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Village of Baltimore to provide a credit card terminal at the Village Town Hall for the convenience and use by residents and others who desire to pay financial obligations owed to the Village, including but not being limited to utility bills, shelter house rental fees, swimming pool memberships, Mayor's Court fees; and,

WHEREAS, Elavon/U.S. Bank has submitted a proposal to the Village for such service fee program, and the proposed agreement between the Village and Elavon/U.S. Bank sets forth the duties and services to be provided by the service fee program, and the compensation to be paid by the Village and credit card users for such services; and,

WHEREAS, Finance Committee has reviewed the proposed agreement and recommends adoption of the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Elavon/U.S. Bank, for the provision of a service fee program for the convenience and use by Village residents and others, who desire to pay financial obligations to the Village by use of a credit card. A copy of the Agreement for the provision of the service fee program, is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest period authorized by law.




