AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO ANTHEM BLUE CROSS-BLUE SHIELD OF CINCINNATI, OHIO, TO SUPPLY HEALTH INSURANCE TO THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: Anthem Blue Cross-Blue Shield of 1351 William Howard Taft Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45206, is hereby awarded the contract to supply the employees of the Village of Baltimore with health insurance coverage for the period of October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017, per the rates contained in the insurance quote attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator is authorized and hereby directed to execute any and all documents necessary to facilitate the award noted in Section 1 of this ordinance. The Village Administrator is further authorized to renew all future contracts with any health care provider without Council action if the insurance premium rates result in an increase of less than ten percent (10%) over the then current premium rates in effect.

SECTION 3: An emergency is hereby declared to exist because the current Village employee health insurance plan is scheduled to lapse on September 30, 2016, and the award and execution of a new health insurance policy is necessary for the health and safety of the residents of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
