A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FUNDS FOR CEMETERY, PARKS, POLICE AND MAYOR'S COURT, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to obtain formal approval from the State Auditor's Office for the establishment of funds for Fiscal Year 2016 and thereafter for: Cemetery; Parks; Police; and Mayor's Court; and,


WHEREAS, the State Auditor's Office has indicated to the Village that formal approval is needed for the establishment of such funds; and,

WHEREAS, this legislation needs to be approved as soon as possible in order for the Village to transact business regarding these funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION 1: That formal approval by the State Auditor's Office is hereby requested for the establishment of funds for Fiscal Year 2016 and thereafter for: Cemetery; Parks; Police; and Mayor's Court.

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble and in order to have the funds in place for the purpose of receiving and disbursing of funds associated with the Johnson Park restroom facilities, this resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. Therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
