**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 452
OF THE BALTIMORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
(PARKING) TO LIMIT TRAVEL TRAILER AND RECREATIONAL
EQUIPMENT PARKING, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend Chapter 452 of the Baltimore Codified Ordinances (Parking) in order to limit the time period for the parking of travel trailer, recreational equipment and similar vehicles, in residential areas; and,

WHEREAS, Safety Committee has reviewed and recommended these amendments; and,

WHEREAS, this ordinance needs to be adopted on an emergency basis in order to provide for the safety of Village residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL
OF VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO
THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION 1: That Section 452 (Parking) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to provide for a new Section 452.21, which shall read as follows:

**“452.21 TRAVEL TRAILER AND RECREATIONAL EQUIPMENT
PARKING.**

(a) Travel or equipment trailers, motor homes, pickup campers, folding tent trailers, boats or boat trailers and similar recreational equipment or trailers, shall not be parked on streets or alleys in any district where residences are a permitted use, for any period of time exceeding 12 hours.

(b) Whoever violates division (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree (M4).”

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Baltimore, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
